The Honorable David F. Snow retired from the Bench for the United States Bankruptcy Court, Northern District of Ohio at Cleveland, on July 24, 2000. When Judge Snow's successor is sworn in as a United States Bankruptcy Judge at Cleveland, the case assignments in Cleveland will be as follows:

1. The case load for the new judge will consist of:
 - a. All pending Chapter 13 proceedings and related adversary proceedings that were originally assigned to Judge Snow, which were subsequently reassigned to Judge Mary Ann Whipple and Judge Randolph Baxter;
 - b. All pending Chapter 7 business and consumer proceedings and related adversary proceedings that were originally assigned to Judge Snow, which were subsequently reassigned to Judge Baxter and Judge Pat E. Morgenstern-Clarren;
 - c. All pending Chapter 11 proceedings and related adversary proceedings that were originally assigned to Judge Snow, which were subsequently reassigned to Judge Baxter and Judge Morgenstern-Clarren;
 - d. One-third of all pending Chapter 7 business and consumer cases drawn through a random selection process.

2. Judge Baxter's case load will consist of:
 - a. All pending Chapter 11 proceedings and related adversary proceedings previously assigned to him;
 - b. All pending Chapter 13 proceedings and related adversary proceedings previously assigned to him;

- c. One-third of all pending Chapter 7 business and consumer cases drawn through a random selection process.

3. Judge Morgenstern-Clarren's case load will consist of:
 - a. All pending Chapter 11 proceedings and related adversary proceedings previously assigned to her;
 - b. All pending Chapter 13 proceedings and related adversary proceedings previously assigned to her;
 - c. One-third of all pending Chapter 7 business and consumer cases drawn through a random selection process.

4. On and after the date of this order, the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court is directed to assign all newly-filed cases pursuant to Local Rule 1073-1.
