Effective December 1, 2022:

General Order 21-01: Order Authorizing Limited Notice in Chapter 12 & 13 Cases Under Amended Bankruptcy Rule 2002(h) is terminated.

On December 1, 2020, Rule 2002(h) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure was amended to permit courts to direct that all notices required by subdivision (a) of Rule 2002 be limited in chapter 12 and chapter 13 cases after the deadline for filing proofs of claim passed, similar to the procedure in effect for chapter 7 cases.

General Order 21-01 was issued on an interim basis until Local Bankruptcy Rule 2002-1 could be amended. On December 1, 2022, Local Bankruptcy Rule 2002-1 was amended and became effective to authorize limited notice in chapter 12 and chapter 13 cases. General Order 21-01 is superseded by amended Local Bankruptcy Rule 2002-1 and is no longer necessary.
