UPON CONSIDERATION, it is hereby ordered that all new Bankruptcy Petitions and Papers shall be filed with the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court serving the county within which the petitioner resides or has his, her or its place of business, excepting those Bankruptcy Petitions which, by law, must be referred to and for the exclusive consideration and attention of a United States District Court Judge.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the aforesaid petitions under the Bankruptcy Act shall be filed in the respective offices of the Bankruptcy Court, as follows:

- At Cleveland: If the petitioner resides in or has his, her or its place of business in the counties of Cuyahoga, Geauga Lake and Lorain.
- At Akron: If the petitioner resides in or has his, her or its place of business in the counties of Medina, Summit and Portage.
- At Canton: If the petitioner resides in or has his, her or its place of business in the counties of Ashland, Carroll, Crawford, Holmes, Richland, Stark, Tuscarawas and Wayne.
- At Youngstown: If the petitioner resides in or has his, her or its place of business in the counties of Ashtabula, Columbiana, Mahoning and Trumbull.
- At Toledo: If the petitioner resides in or has his, her or its place of business in the counties of Allen, Auglaize, Defiance, Erie, Fulton, Hancock, Hardin, Henry, Huron, Lucas, Marion, Mercer, Ottawas, Paulding Putnam, Sandusky, Seneca, Van Wert, Williams, Wood and Wyandot.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the following personnel in the Bankruptcy Courts, who shall remain subject to the jurisdiction of the respective Bankruptcy Court, are hereby designated Deputy Clerks to act for the Clerk of the United States District Court for the Northern District of Ohio in matters relating to the Bankruptcy Act and shall serve without additional compensation:




