O R D E R

On December 22, 2004, Defendant Travelers Casualty and Surety Company ("Travelers") filed a motion to compel the asbestos claimants' law firms to produce the names and addresses of their clients to the Insul Trustee. Responses to Travelers' motion to compel were filed by (1) Baron & Budd, P.C. and Silber Pearlman, LLP; (2) Kelley & Ferraro, LLP; and (3) Goldberg, Persky & White, P.C. On January 7, 2005, Travelers filed a reply in support of its motion to compel. A status conference was held in this matter on January 26, 2005.

It is not clear that Travelers has standing to move to

compel production of information to the Trustee. No discovery requests have been made for the names and addresses of the asbestos claimants nor is there any allegation that the Trustee does not already have the information that Travelers seeks to compel to be produced. Accordingly, the Court denies Travelers' motion to compel the asbestos claimants' law firms to produce the names and addresses of their clients to Andrew W. Suhar, Insul's Trustee.
