ORDER REGARDING OBJECTION TO PROOF OF CLAIM

In accordance with the court's Order Regarding Objection to Proof of Claim entered on December 28, 2007, and its Memorandum of Decision Regarding Objection to Proof of Claim entered on February 4, 2008, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Debtors' Objection to Proof of Claim of Estate of Glenn Pruden [Doc. # 56] be, and hereby is, **SUSTAINED in part** and **OVERRULED in part**; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Claimant's claim shall be allowed in the amount of \$28,483.14, plus simple interest at a rate of 6% calculated as follows:

1. For the period from November 24, 1998, through February 28, 2001 – 6% interest shall be calculated on the principal amount of \$31,494.93;
2. For the period from February 29, 2001, until confirmation of Debtor's Chapter 13 plan – 6% interest shall be calculated on the principal amount of \$28,483.14; and
3. Interest after confirmation shall be paid as provided in any confirmed plan.
